Administrative – Required Reporting (REMINDER)

- In order to maintain viability and to ensure that all Chapters are meeting the needs of their members, each Chapter is <u>required to submit annual reports</u>.
- Scheduling and reporting meetings requires an IEEE Account and must be done using vTools events.
- Officers can schedule future events or report an event that has taken place via vTools. All meetings, including those scheduled in vTools, must be reported with the number of members and guests attended
- All meetings, including social events and administrative meetings must be held. Categories include (administrative/executive committee meetings, professional development meetings, technical meetings such as technical talks or DL's, non-technical meetings such as social activities or awards dinners, and humanitarian meetings).
- Minimum meeting requirements are as follows: FIVE meetings for sections and subsections, TWO meetings for Chapters, and TWO meetings for Affinity Groups

Important: Notify SSCS Executive Office of any changes to Chapter Officers, Events, etc.



Activities – Why Invite DLs

- Roster of well-known and established speakers
- SSCS (not chapter) pays for speaker's travel
- OK to live-stream DL talks, not OK to publicly post DL slides or video until speaker's term is over (make sure you have DL's approval to record talk and post later)
- Must include/inform Frank O'Mahony (<u>frank.omahony@intel.com</u>) in invitation email to DL speaker
- Inform Ashley once DL is secured for posting to chapter website

2021	36	\$ 60,886	\$ 70,100	\$ 76,400
2022	43	\$ 64,970	\$ 67,100	\$ 81,000

- SSCS single chapters are eligible for up to \$2,000 a year to subsidize chapter maintenance costs or activities, Joint Chapters are eligible for up to \$1,000 a year
- Use Concentration Banking accounts for fastest disbursement of funds
- New chapters should immediately apply for subsidies
- Call pending for additional subsidy requests for pre-university activities
- Pull in subsidy in 2023 so that funds get to your hands early
 - Call for 2023 subsidy requests in October \rightarrow mid-December deadline
